Hello, from Kentucky WMU!

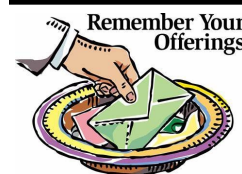

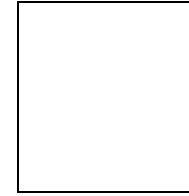
